

Important Information Regarding:

New Zealand Severe Weather

Issued: 15th August 2011

Applies to all Travelsure products

The following advice relates to policies issued before the 15th August 2011.

This advice is in regards to the severe weather currently being experienced in Queenstown, New Zealand.

Snow storms have affected large parts of New Zealand and forced the cancellation of numerous flights out of Dunedin, Christchurch, Queenstown and Invercargill airports.

ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT EXPENSES

If you are on Your Journey there is provision to cover reasonable additional hotel accommodation and transport expenses up to \$250 per paying adult on the policy if your scheduled transport is delayed for at least 12 hours due to severe weather conditions.

In addition to the amount specified above if you have an Options, Essentials or Select policy there is also provision under the Travel Delay section to claim for reasonable additional accommodation expenses up to \$200 if your pre-booked transport is temporarily delayed for at least 6 hours. We will also reimburse you up to this limit again for each full 24 hour period that the delay continues beyond the initial 6 hour delay.

When submitting your claim you will need to provide written confirmation from the transport provider of the length of the delay along with itemised receipts for the accommodation and transport expenses incurred.

Many airlines are waiving their normal penalties associated with changing flights. You should check with your airline about whether your flight has been affected and what alternative arrangements have been put in place.

The policy defines Additional as meaning:

"the cost of the accommodation or transport You actually use less the cost of the accommodation or transport You expected to use had the journey proceeded as planned".

AMENDMENT OR CANCELLATION COSTS

There is provision to claim Amendment costs if your travel plans have been directly affected by the severe weather conditions prior to you leaving your home to begin your Journey. There is also provision to claim for cancellation costs for the parts of your Journey which have been directly affected by the severe weather conditions.

Please contact your travel agent or travel provider regarding the best option for you in altering your trip. You must take all reasonable steps to minimise your claim and keep documentation showing what your original

planned pre-paid arrangements were, along with receipts and documentation showing what your new arrangements are. The policy provides cover for amendment or cancellation (whichever is less).

No cover will be provided for the utilised portion of prepaid travel arrangements. If you are claiming additional accommodation or transport expenses there is no provision to also claim for the cancellation cost of pre-paid travel arrangements for the same period. The policy also excludes cover for loss of enjoyment.

There is no provision to claim for Amendment or Cancellation costs if your travel arrangements are operating as scheduled.

Corporate and Annual Multi-Trip Policies

The above advice also applies to Corporate and Annual Multi-Trip policies, however please note there is an additional requirement that your original travel arrangements must have been booked prior to the 15th August 2011.

Customers stuck overseas who cannot return home

For customers who hold a Travelsure policy issued prior to the 15th August 2011 and cannot return home on their original return date due to the severe weather, their policy will automatically extend free of charge to allow them to return by the quickest and most direct route.

As this extension is automatic, customers and agents do not need to do anything.

IMPORTANT - GENERAL ADVICE

This information must be read in conjunction with the Travelsure Policy Wording as certain restrictions and exclusions apply.

These exclusions and restrictions are detailed in the Travelsure Policy Wording and in particular we draw your attention to "The Benefits" and "General Exclusions" sections of the Policy Wording.
