



Important Information Regarding: Travel to India Issued: 4th May 2010

Applies to all Travelsure products

The New Zealand Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade have updated their travel advice to India on the 1st of May 2010. Please refer to www.safetravel.govt.nz for the latest travel advice. MFAT have stated (in part);

There is some risk to your security elsewhere in India due to the threat from terrorism and we advise caution.

There is a significant threat from terrorism in India and New Zealanders travelling in India should take account of the potential for terrorist attacks by militant group

CANCELLATION/ AMENDMENT COSTS

All Travelsure products exclude cancellation or amendment costs arising directly or indirectly from any Act of Terrorism or the threat or perceived threat of an Act of Terrorism.

MEDICAL/ REPATRIATION COSTS

All Travelsure products provide cover for medical expenses if you are injured in a terrorist attack. Travelsure products also provide cover for additional transport costs if it is medically necessary to evacuate you back to New Zealand following you being injured in a terrorist attack.

IMPORTANT - GENERAL ADVICE

This information must be read in conjunction with the Travelsure Policy Wording as certain restrictions apply.

Coverage differs between the Travelsure products but no cover is provided for any Act of Terrorism or the threat or perceived threat of an Act of Terrorism under the sections; Amendment or Cancellation Costs, Travel Delay or Missed Connection. Customers should refer to the policy wording including the section "We Will Not Under Any Section Pay For" for full details.

An Act Of Terrorism means an act, including but not limited to the use of force or violence, of any person or group(s) of persons, whether acting alone or on behalf of or in connection with any organisation(s) or government(s), which from its nature or context is done for, or in connection with, political, religious, ideological, ethnic or similar purposes or reasons, including the intention to influence any government and/or to put the public, or any section of the public in fear.
